Dream Bus use continues to be steady with new patrons. As of 11/22/21, there were 311 visitors and 12 new library cards issued at the Dream Bus in November.

As you know, we received a Wisconsin Humanities Council Recovery grant in the amount of \$9,942 towards marketing Ripple Programming in 2022. The BTP Coordinator is matching libraries with their program picks and getting the initial schedule together for the end of the year.

# **Reimbursement formula.**

At the Dane County Library meeting in November, there was overwhelming support to again repeat the 2021 reimbursement and look at a new formula. I have seven volunteers for a formula workgroup that will meet beginning December 1. We will look at a variety of options, including Waukesha County's formula, using circulation as ONE component of the formula, valuations and collection budgets.
