7	Dane County Parks is partnering with Ducks Unlimited and the US Fish and Wildlife Service on
8	a large wetland and prairie restoration project in the Walking Iron Wildlife Area. The project
9	includes creating waterfowl scrapes, filling ditches and seeding the entire project area with
10	native prairie and wetland.
11	
12	The project has many water quality benefits, including allowing the water to filter through the
13	wetland before it eventually enters the Wisconsin River, increasing groundwater recharge and
14	providing excellent waterfowl and pheasant hunting habitat.

16	The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources increased their Pheasant Stamp Funding
17	Contribution to the project by \$28,000 to be used for upland seeding.
18	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RECOLVED that the Days County Days of Companies are and the

20	Dane County Executive hereby accept \$28,000 from the WI Department of Natural Resources.
