AUTHORIZING WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES GRANT FUNDING FOR OPIOID ABATEMENT EFFORTS

## **Policy Analysis Statement:**

#### Brief Description of Proposal -

Request authorization to accept grant funding of \$247,681 from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services to expand the jail Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) Program to support one deputy position for jail resident movement for methadone delivery, MAT assessments, chronic care evaluations and programming and, one .5 FTE nurse practitioner or physician's assistant, to focus on MAT-related services exclusively.

# Current Policy or Practice -

Acceptance of grant funding requires County Board approval.

# Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Providing opioid use disorder treatment access to jail residents on-site decreases the likelihood of withdrawal during incarceration and fatal overdose post-release and, will significantly reduce the need to transport jail residents to an Opioid Treatment Program.
