## AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A CONTRACT FOR ELECTRONIC GPS AND ALCOHOL MONITORING SERVICES

The Sheriff's Office monitors and maintains a Jail Diversion Program which includes Custody Alternative Monitoring Program (CAMP) and the Pathfinder Program. The Clerk of Courts has an Alternatives to Incarceration Program (ATIP) and the Department of Human Services maintains a program for Juvenile Justice clients on either a custody order or court order. Individuals participating in these programs are monitored by active GPS tracking with an electronic device and may be confined to their homes. In addition, individuals may also be monitored with alcohol monitoring equipment.

Electronic GPS and Alcohol monitoring services are available on GSA Federal Supply Schedule 84, Contract #GS-07F-0003Y.

Alcohol Monitoring Systems Inc., (AMS Inc.) 1241 West Mineral Avenue, Suite 200, Littleton, CO 80120 holds GSA Federal Supply Schedule 84, Contract #GS-07F-0003Y for Law Enforcement and Security Equipment.

Dane County is authorized to purchase under GSA Federal Supply Schedule 84 because the Federal Local Preparedness Acquisition Act (Public Law 110-248) authorized state and local governments access to Federal Supply Schedule 84, Total Solutions for Law Enforcement, Security, Facility Management Systems, Fire, Rescue, Special Purpose Clothing, Marine Craft, Emergency/Disaster Response, and Schedule 70 for information technology products and services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that a contract is awarded to AMS, Inc., in the amount not to exceed \$2,500,000 for jail diversion monitoring services, to begin November 8, 2016 and continuing through September 30, 2021.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Dane County Executive and the Dane County Clerk are authorized to execute the necessary documents for the contract.
