Dane County Board of Supervisors does ordain as follows:

The Zoning Districts Maps as referenced under Dane County Code of Ordinance Section 10.200(4) shall be amended as follows:

Town Map: Town of Vermont Location: Section 7

Zoning District Boundary Changes FP-35 to RR-2

Part of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 7, Town 7 North, Range 6 East, Town of Vermont, Dane County, Wisconsin, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the East 1/4 corner of said Section 7; thence N02°31'42"E, 1320.85' to the Northeast corner of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 7; thence S89°24'18"W along the North line of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 7, 496.00' to the point of beginning; thence S89°24'18"W, 427.58'; thence S34°59'34"W, 227.44'; thence S65°03'30"E, 505.92' to the centerline of County Trunk Highway F; thence Northeasterly, 108.37' along said centerline and the arc of a curve to the right whose radius is 2100.00' and whose chord bears N36°32'32"E, 108.36'; thence N38°01'14"E along said centerline, 163.76'; thence N19°22'20"W, 199.34' to the point of beginning; subject to a public road right of way as shown and to any and all easements of record.

CONDITIONAL ZONING

Conditional zoning is hereby imposed pursuant to Section 10.101(8)(d) of the Dane County Code of Ordinances. The rezoned area shall be subject to the following conditions.

CERTIFIED SURVEY REQUIRED

The above listed description/s is/are intended to describe land for which a certified survey map will be prepared for approval and recorded. Within **6 months** of rezoning approval by Dane County, a *final* certified survey map that describes the land to be rezoned shall be prepared in accordance with all applicable provisions of Chapter 236 Wisconsin Statutes and Chapter 75 Dane County Code of Ordinances, and submitted to the Dane County Zoning Division. Upon submission of the final certified survey map, the Zoning and Land Regulation Committee, or its authorized representative, shall, within 30 days, approve, approve conditionally, or reject the certified survey map. Failure to submit the final certified survey within the 6-month period <u>and/or</u> failure to record the survey with the Dane County Register of Deeds will cause the rezone to be null and void. Two copies of the recorded survey shall be submitted to Dane County Zoning.
