AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A WDNR GRANT FOR A SNOWMOBILE TRAIL BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT – MARXVILLE OVER HALFWAY PRAIRIE CREEK

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

Land & Water Resources – Parks Division has received a grant for \$17,400 from the WI Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) for a Snowmobile Trail Bridge Rehabilitation Project. The purpose of the grant is to replace a deteriorating snowmobile trail bridge with a new bridge. This bridge is located in the Town of Berry on State Corridor #21 over the Halfway Prairie Creek and is maintained by the White Lightning Snowmobile Club.

Current Policy or Practice -

Acceptance of grants requires County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Dane County Parks will work with the White Lightning Snowmobile Club to complete this project. Once the project is complete, WDNR will reimburse Dane County for 100% of the costs up to \$17,400.
