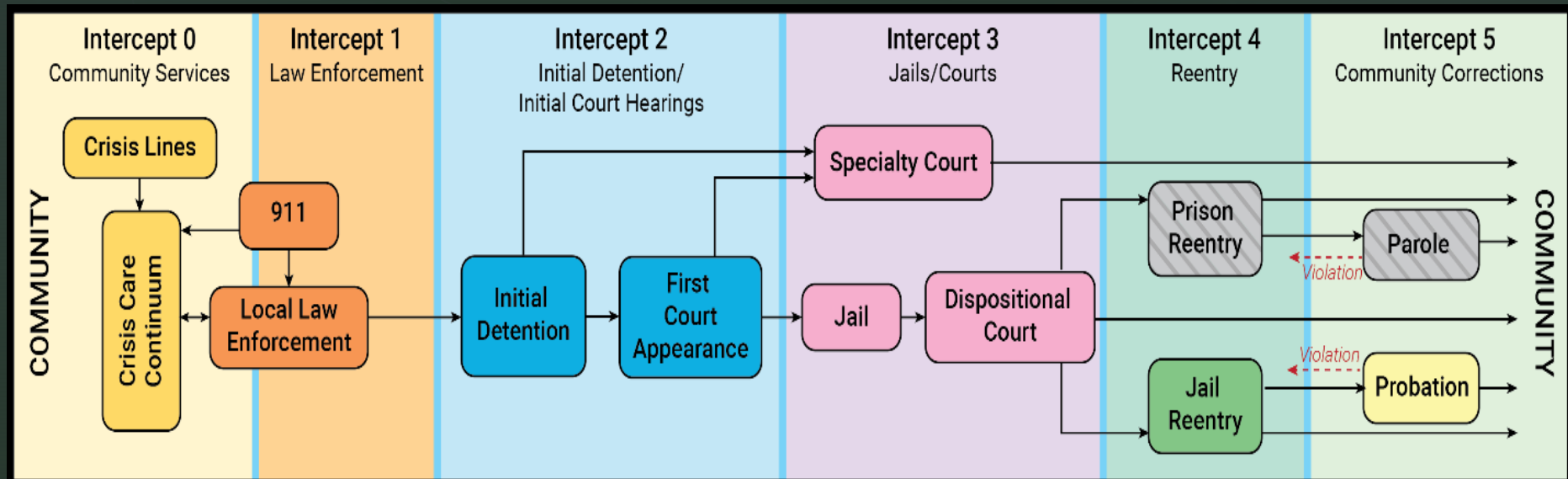

# Sequential Intercept Model—Designed to aid in analysis of the behavioral health intersection with criminal justice

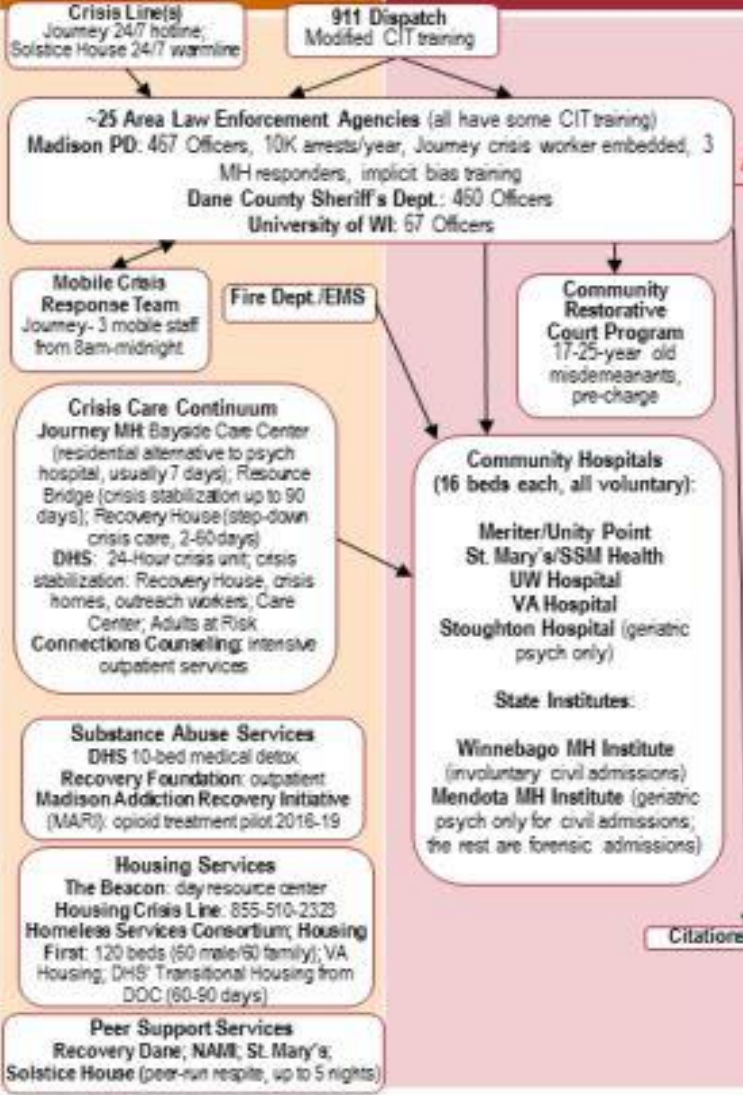


Intercept 0 focus is on community-based crisis prevention, intervention and stabilization continuum. As such, it should work seamlessly with Intercept 1.
