## 2023 RES-017 RECOGNIZING APRIL AS NATIONAL CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH

**WHEREAS**, April 2023 is National Child Abuse Prevention Month and recognizes the importance of families and communities working together to prevent child abuse and neglect; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2021, the Dane County Human Services Department received 4,488 access reports (referrals), an increase of 7.9% from 2020; of these, 147 reports, or 3%, were substantiated; and

**WHEREAS**, child abuse can have long-term psychological, emotional, and physical effects that have lasting consequences for victims of abuse; and

**WHEREAS**, child abuse prevention is a community responsibility and finding solutions depends on people becoming involved, asking questions, making critical decisions, and offering help; and

**WHEREAS**, effective child abuse prevention activities succeed because of the partnerships created between child welfare professionals, education, health, community- and faith-based organizations, businesses, law enforcement agencies, and families; and

**WHEREAS**, communities must make every effort to promote programs and activities that create strong and thriving children and families; and

**WHEREAS**, our children are our most valuable resources and will shape the future of Dane County.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors recognizes April 2023 as National Child Abuse Prevention Month.
