1. Activity Report

Chair Haight deferred to Acting Airport Director, Jones who reported that May passenger activity was up overall year to date 5.6% and up 13.7% from the same month last year. The schedule for the summer looks solid. Some airlines are looking into upgrading equipment and adding scheduled flights.

Jones was excited to report that Sun Country will begin new air service beginning at the end of September with direct round trip flights to Fort Myers and Tampa. Meetings to work out the details are currently under way. In addition there have been inquiries from other airlines for potential new service.

Jones reported that Air Park matters are in really good shape, overall. Building projects are underway and any need for approval of new lease assignments would be forthcoming to this commision.
