Expansion of SEL online tool/curriculum;creation of calming spaces;funds for family outdoor wellness
Purchase SEL Curriculum for HS & Train staff on material; no current SEL program at HS
Training for teachers 6-12 on appropriate developmental responses to students in stress;calming sensory items for calming spaces; emergency fund for immediate mh supports for unfunded/uninsured students
2FTE Resources Navigators and 1FTE Bilngual Mental Health Specialist for 18 months; 6K for translation and tranportation subcontrats
Paying staff in summer to attend Restorative Practices Training; other funds are for materials and activities as follows: Short term parent coaching - coping skills; restorative practice training for staff and peer support circles ;Mental Health 1st Aid Training for staff and caregivers; sensory items for students
