ACCEPTING A WI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES GRANT
FOR THE GYPSY MOTH SUPPRESSION PROGRAM

The Land & Water Resources Department has received a \$25,088.04 Gypsy Moth Suppression Program Grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR).

Dane County serves as the coordinating agency which allows for municipalities to be eligible for cost sharing through the WDNR. The program works to suppress damaging gypsy moth populations with an aerial insecticide treatment should conditions warrant. This year, the City of Madison has requested treatment from the WDNR for 501.3 acres and the City of Sun Prairie has requested treatment for 51.3 acres.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby authorize the Gypsy Moth Suppression grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that revenue and expense accounts LWRPKOP 81616 & LWPRKOP 21130 be increased by \$25,088.04. All funds shall carry forward until realized and expended.
