AWARDING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT TO THE SUPERVISORY LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

This resolution approves the terms and conditions of a one-year successor agreement between Dane County and the Supervisory Law Enforcement Unit. The County employs approximately 45 full time equivalent Sergeants and Lieutenants in this bargaining unit. The agreement includes hourly wage increases, changes to employee health insurance contributions, and other items. The new agreement will expire on December 9, 2017.

Current Policy or Practice -

The current agreement with the Supervisory Law Enforcement Unit expired on December 10, 2016.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The agreement includes a 2% hourly wage increase in PP 3 and an additional 1% hourly wage increase in PP 14 for bargaining unit employees. The agreement also reflects a change in employee health insurance premium contributions for those employees who select a POS plan under the County's new health insurance benefit.
