AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FY 2020 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM

The City of Madison and Dane County are participating in the FY 2020 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program that awarded \$83,389 to the City of Madison, Grant Number BJA-2020-17276. The City of Madison will receive \$62,929 from the allocation of \$83,389 and Dane County will receive \$20,460 for the following:

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\$9,977 for the Dane County Human Services Drug Court Treatment Program:

12 13  \$5,439 to the Dane County Sheriff's Office to purchase automated external defibrillators (AED's); and

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• \$4,990 for the Dane County District Attorney Crime Response Program.

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Grant funding for the Drug Court Treatment Program of \$9,977 and for the District Attorney's Crime Response Program \$4,990 shall be reflected in their 2021 Adopted Budget.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Sheriff's Office accepts FY 2020 Justice Assistance Grant funding, administered by the City of Madison, in the amount of \$5,439; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED \$5,439 is established as revenue in Sheriff's Office Support Services Division, Justice Assistance Grant Revenue (SHRFSUP 83139) and is credited to the General Fund; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$5,439 is transferred from the General Fund to Sheriff's Office Support Services Division, Justice Assistance Grant Expenditure account line (SHRFSUP 47680).

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BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED grant funds not expended as of December 31, 2020, be carried forward to the FY 2021 budget period.

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## **Memorandum of Understanding**

#### Between

## The City of Madison and Dane County

The City of Madison and Dane County wish to participate in and obtain the benefits of the FY2020 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program. As part of the application process, the parties are required to submit a proposed plan for the allocation and administration of the funds awarded. The City of Madison by Mayor Satya Rhodes-Conway and Dane County by Executive Joseph Parisi have prepared and signed this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the aforementioned purpose. It is understood that acceptance of the MOU by each of these agencies is contingent upon the adoption of the required authorizing resolutions by appropriate governing bodies. Conditioned on the foregoing, the parties state as follows:

The City of Madison and Dane County agree to the proposal for the allocation of the \$83,389 awarded under the FY2020 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program:

1. Funding will be allocated as follows:

Dane County will receive \$20,460 that shall be used as follows:

- \$9,977 for the Human Services Drug Court treatment program
- \$5,493 to the Sheriff's Office for automated external defibrillators (AEDs)
- \$4,990 for the District Attorney Crime Response Program victim/witness services

The City of Madison Police Department will receive \$62,929 that shall be used as follows:

- \$32,929 for a radio base station, monitors and chairs
- \$30,000 for strategic planning

Any interest earned will be applied toward the administrative costs of the Madison Police Department.

For the purposes of this MOU, the funds will be used from the start date of the grant award through the calendar year of 2021.

- 2. The parties agree that the City of Madison will apply for and administer the FY2020Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant. Administration of the grant includes the following:
  - Each agency receiving funding through this grant will request reimbursement of expenses on a quarterly basis from the Madison Police Department (MPD). The MPD will not be responsible for sending reminders to the County regarding completion of requests for reimbursement.
  - o Reimbursement requests will include documentation of expenses as required under federal guidelines for grant expenditures.
  - The final requests for reimbursement must be submitted no later than January 15, 2022.
  - Each agency receiving funding will also complete quarterly performance measures, which provide data that measures the results of their work. These reports will be due no later than fifteen days after the close of each quarter. Performance measure information will be provided to the County upon receipt of the formal grant award.
  - Each agency will complete a semiannual progress report and submit it to MPD no later than July 15 and January 15 of each year the grant is active. The format for the

annual progress report will be provided to the County upon receipt of the formal grant award.

- o Each agency receiving funding through this grant agrees to comply with any additional reporting requirements that are required by the grant-awarding agency as a condition of the grant.
- o If the County fails to complete timely reports, funding may be reallocated at the discretion of the Chief of Police for the City of Madison.
- 3. Each agency is solely responsible to ensure that all items for which they are reimbursed meet the federal requirements for use of funds, including but not limited to all non-supplanting criteria.
