C. Action Items

Data Export to Dane County

Meier asked the Commission to discuss EMS data into the Dane Bridge patient care reporting platform. For those agencies that have not moved onto the County platform we would like to have them use consistent language with incident number from 911 center. This will improve efficiencies when analyzing data. Salov also suggested we add to the memo the positive reasons to utilize the Dane County patient care reporting system. Meier will revise the memo to add this and then distribute to DeForest, DeerGrove and Sun Prairie.

D. Discussion Items

Budget 2017

Tubbs reports that he is working to secure a clerical position in the 2017 budget, he is confident it will be funded. The Commission discussed their support of this and their resources as needed. Keeping pace with workload this position is needed.

ALS Data Report

Lohmeier shared that the data analysis of auto ALS codes is near completion but the recent challenge with data as discussed in an earlier topic has added some challenges. Official report will be ready at September Commission meeting.

Regionalization

Salov asked the Commission whether they are inclined to drive regionalization forward. Much discussion ensued including feedback from service directors. Hillebrand spoke to input from the Legislative Workgroup that began meeting Tuesday to discuss staffing concerns around the State. This workgroup has been tasked to have a position by the end of this year. Ziegler suggested polling the districts to see their thoughts on this topic. Suggestion was made to bring in speakers who have experienced this elsewhere. Allain and Erschen spoke openly about their work to bring the idea of regionalization to their municipalities. They spoke to some of the challenges and benefits of such a collaboration. The Commission discussed the need for the general population to understand the concerns that face EMS today. The item was concluded with a plan to meet at the August meeting and have a speaker on regionalization efforts and discuss concerns with Commission, Chiefs, residents, public officials interested in attending.
