1 Sub. to 2017 RES-498 (proposed Dye) 2 AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF MICROSOFT 3 LICENSING AND MICROSOFT SERVER LICENSING 4 5 The 2018 Budget includes funding to enter into a new Enterprise Agreement with Microsoft to 6 upgrade and extend the County's Microsoft software licenses. This resolution authorizes 7 licensing for servers and will complete the County's licensing obligations with Microsoft for a 8 three year period. 9 10 The licensing agreement provides Datacenter and SQL server licensing for a three year period at 11 a cost of \$632,717.88631,140.48 (\$210,905.96210,380.16 Annually). These licenses are 12 necessary to support the physical and virtual servers that host and support end user 13 applications. 14 15 This licensing agreement includes Software Assurance (SA) which provides updates and support 16 for Windows Office products and Citrix access capabilities at a cost of 17 \$1,018,593.331,027,998.36 (\$339,531.11342,666.12 Annually). The agreement also grants 18 access to training vouchers for technical staff, online learning, implementation planning 19 services, technical support services, and the home use program. 20 21 The project is budgeted to cost \$1,651,311.211,659,138.84 that will cover any upgrades that are 22 needed during a three-year period. At the end of this three-year commitment, the County may 23 decide to purchase another three-year licensing package or to discontinue the agreement. 24 25 The term of the debt issued to fund this project will be three years. 26 27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that County Executive and County Clerk are authorized to 28 enter into an agreement with SHI International CorpCDW-Government LLC to purchase Server 29 and Cloud Enrollment (SCE) licensing and Microsoft licensing as authorized in the 2018 Budget; 30 and 31 32
