CREATING .50 FTE FOOD STAMP EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING POSITION IN 2015 DCDHS - EAWS DIVISION

### **Policy Analysis Statement:**

## Brief Description of Proposal -

Dane County has been awarded the Food Stamp Employment and Training Contract from the State of Wisconsin. The approved plan includes a .50 FTE FSET Contract Manager. This resolution requests the addition of a .50 FTE ES Supervisor position that will perform program coordination, contract monitoring responsibilities of site visits, performance standard monitoring, and quality of programming; oversee the Employment and Training Coalition, and quality assurance duties. The FSET100 revenue is already in the Department's 2015 budget. The FSET Employment and Training Expenditure will be reallocated to facilitate the creation of the .5 FTE FSET Contract Manager.

## Current Policy or Practice -

Budget and professional service contract changes require County Board approval.

.50 FTE ES Supervisor position will be created, funded by FSET Employment and Training funds .
