NOW COMES your Claimant, Parish Barbary-Weatherby, 2293 South Thompson Drive, Apt. 2, Madison, WI 53716, who hereby gives notice of his claim for damages pursuant to § 893.80, Wis. Stats., against the Dane County Sheriff's Office and the officers, employees, and agents of said governmental bodies by those above-named from February 14, 2018 to March 14, 2018.

1. From February 14, 2018, to March 14, 2018, Claimant Parish Barnaby-Weatherby was an inmate at the Dane County Jail. While Claimant Parish Barnaby-Weatherby was in custody, nurses and other staff of the Dane County Jail negligently and recklessly failed to provide Claimant Parish Barnaby-Weatherby with his necessary prescription medications and negligently and recklessly failed to administer care to Claimant Parish Barnaby-Weatherby when he entered into diabetic shock on March 9, 2018.


2. All nurses, doctors, and other staff of the Dane County Jail at all times material herein, and specifically from February 14 to March 14, 2018, were employees of Dane County and were acting within the scope of their employment for Dane County. Dane County shall pay any judgment as to damages and costs entered against its individual agents pursuant to § 895.46, Wis. Stats.

3. As a direct and proximate result and consequence of the negligence of the nurses and other staff at the Dane County Jail, Claimant Parish Barbary-Weatherby has suffered past and future bodily injury, past and future physical pain and suffering, past and future medical expenses, and past and future emotional distress.

4. This claim is hereby made within 120 days of the happening of the event giving rise to the claim.
