The Prairie Enthusiasts are working to acquire an 77 acre property in the Town of Blue Mounds for the project. If acquired, the property will be actively managed for wildlife habitat and public access. The Prairie Enthusiasts is requesting a Dane County Conservation Fund Grant for 50% of the acquisition costs, approximately \$395,000.
