A motion was made by CORRIGAN, seconded by DYE, that Sub __ to Resolution 355 be amended as follows: Amend page 1, line 18, by deleting Item 6 starting on Line 18 and adding that paragraph to end of the Local Government Services section of the document.

The motion carried 6-0.

A motion was made by STUBBS, seconded by KOLAR, that Sub __ to Resolution 355 be amended as follows: Amend page 1, line 25, by adding after the word "include" "Child Welfare, Economic Well-Being, Family Structure" to read as follows:

"The elimination of racial disparities and the elevation of racial equity are among the most important priorities and responsibilities of Dane County. Specific areas that help alleviate racial disparities include Child Welfare, Economic Well-Being, Family Structure, Youth Initiatives, Education, Prevention, Employment, Criminal Justice, Health Care, Housing, Transportation, Economic Development, Contracting and Service Delivery."

The motion carried 6-0.

A motion was made by KOLAR, seconded by DYE, that Sub __ to Resolution 355 be amended as follows: Amend page 1, line 42, by deleting the word "boomer" to read as follows: "Expedite entry and graduation from the programs to meet increasing demands to fill vacancies created by an aging workforce."

The motion carried 6-0.

A motion was made by CHENOWETH, seconded by KOLAR, that Sub _____ to Resolution 355 be amended as follows: Amend pages 6-9, lines 313-463, by restoring the deleted language in this section.

The motion carried 7-0

A motion was made by KOLAR, seconded by CHENOWETH, that Sub _____ to Resolution 355 be amended as follows: Amend page 8, line 386-388, by inserting ", including" after "Dane County water programs", deleting "(water" before "regulatory programs", and deleting ")and others)." to read as follows:

23) DNR Budget Reductions: Oppose reductions in DNR staffing that affect Dane County water programs, including regulatory programs, lake/fishery, runoff specialists, conservation wardens, land conservation and parks programs.

The motion carried 7-0

A motion was made by KOLAR, seconded by CHENOWETH, that Sub _____ to Resolution 355 be amended as follows: Amend page 8, lines 396-399, by deleting the following language: "Reduce greenhouse air pollution by updating and implementing the Governor's Global Warming Task Force recommendations and increasing funding for county energy efficiency measures" and adding new language to read as follows:

29) Greenhouse Air Pollution: Provide funding for county-level climate action planning, mitigation, and adaptation.

The motion carried 7-0

A motion was made by DYE, seconded by KOLAR, that Sub __ to Resolution 355 be amended as follows: Amend page 3, lines 124-127, by moving them to the end of Line 116 in the "Medicaid Expansion" paragraph to read as follows:

"25) Medicaid Expansion: Support implementation of the Medicaid expansion under the federal Affordable Care Act (ACA). Allow Wisconsin to use the Medicaid option to close the gap in BadgerCare for childless adults. If WI closes the gap, full federal funding will be available for three years 2014-2016, followed by gradual reductions to 90% by 2020. ACA creates other innovative benefits and programs that states and counties will help to implement, including a new mandatory coverage group for young adults who leave foster care up to the age of 26 years old. Accept available federal funds for BadgerCare to ensure that thousands of Wisconsin citizens have access to quality and affordable health coverage."

The motion carried 7-0

A motion was made by CORRIGAN, seconded by CHENOWETH, that Sub _____ to Resolution 355 be amended as follows: Amend page 3, to add on line 124 the following language:

"29) Prevailing Wage: Oppose legislation that eliminates the prevailing wage requirement for public works and other projects. The prevailing wage guarantees fair bids, quality work, and middle class wages for skilled workers in Dane County."

The motion carried 6-1 (Ripp voting no)

A motion was made by DYE, seconded by KOLAR, that Sub _____ to Resolution 355 be amended as follows: Amend page 4, line 190, to delete "Enacted a referendum for Spring 2014 Election ballot, "Should the state enact legislation"" and add: "Support Legislation " to read:

"22) Legalize Marijuana: Support legislation legalizing marijuana. Dane County voters approved by 64.5% yes votes and 35.5% no votes."

The motion carried 7-0

A motion was made by DYE, seconded by CHENOWETH, that Sub _____ to Resolution 355 be amended as follows:Amend page 16, line 839, to delete "Enacted a referendum for Spring 2014 Election ballot, "Should the Wisconsin Constitution be amended" and add: "Support Legislation" to read:

"48) Nonpartisan Redistricting: Support legislation to require a nonpartisan system for redistricting legislative and congressional districts in the state. Dane County voters approved by 82.1% yes votes and 17.9% no votes."

Motion carried 7-0

A motion was made by CHENOWETH, seconded by KOLAR, that Sub __ to Resolution 355 be approved as amended as Sub 1 to Resolution 355. The motion carried 6-1 (Ripp voting no).
