AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT TO ACCEPT HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT FUNDS FOR A HIGH VISIBILITY MOTORCYCLE OWI ENFORCEMENT CAMPAIGN, GRANT NUMBER FG-2014-DANE CO-2495

The Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, State of Wisconsin, is making funding available for participation in a 2014 High Visibility Motorcycle Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) Enforcement Campaign, Grant Number FG-2014-DANE CO-2495, funding available October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014. The goal of this federally funded enforcement initiative is to decrease the number of motorcycle crashes from motorcycle events where alcohol is sold. The targeted enforcement is intended to increase the perception of law enforcement's presence, to deter drinking and operating of motorcycles, to improve traffic safety, and to reduce crashes. Traffic laws will be enforced in and around cities, towns, and general locations where motorcycle specific events and activities occur.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to accept \$4,058 from the Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, for the high visibility motorcycle operating while intoxicated enforcement initiative, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$4,058 is set up as additional revenue in the Sheriff's Office, Field Services Motorcycle OWI Enforcement revenue account line (SHRFFLD-New) and to be credited to the General Fund, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$4,058 is transferred from the General Fund to the following accounts:
