6 **AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT TO ACCEPT HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT FUNDS**
7 **FOR A HIGH VISIBILITY MOTORCYCLE OWI ENFORCEMENT CAMPAIGN,**
8 **GRANT NUMBER FG-2014-DANE CO-2495**

10 The Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, State of Wisconsin,
11 is making funding available for participation in a 2014 High Visibility Motorcycle Operating While
12 Intoxicated (OWI) Enforcement Campaign, Grant Number FG-2014-DANE CO-2495, funding
13 available October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014. The goal of this federally funded
14 enforcement initiative is to decrease the number of motorcycle crashes from motorcycle events
15 where alcohol is sold. The targeted enforcement is intended to increase the perception of law
16 enforcement's presence, to deter drinking and operating of motorcycles, to improve traffic
17 safety, and to reduce crashes. Traffic laws will be enforced in and around cities, towns, and
18 general locations where motorcycle specific events and activities occur.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to
21 accept \$4,058 from the Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, for the
22 high visibility motorcycle operating while intoxicated enforcement initiative, and

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that \$4,058 is set up as additional revenue in the Sheriff's
25 Office, Field Services Motorcycle OWI Enforcement revenue account line (SHRFFLD-New) and
26 to be credited to the General Fund, and

28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that \$4,058 is transferred from the General Fund to the
29 following accounts:

Social Security (SHRFFLD-10108)	\$300
Retirement Fund (SHRFFLD-10099)	\$400
Workers Compensation (SHRFFLD-10189)	<u>\$100</u>
