

AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF TRAINING GRANT

FOR

HAZMAT RESPONSE TRAINING/HAZMAT IQ

Dane County Emergency Management was awarded a training grant from Wisconsin Emergency Management totaling \$5,950.00.

This training grant award will be used to deliver "HazMat Response Training/HazMat IQ." This is a specialized proprietary HazMat training program taught by nationally recognized instructors. Course participants will learn how to quickly assess and categorize a HazMat incident, thus determining personal protection equipment requirements, equipment needed to mitigate the situation, and decon needs. This technician level training is not available within the Madison Fire Department.

Total cost for this training is \$5,950 which includes instructors and material fees. This course will be repeated three times (over the course of three days) to incorporate "shifts" of fire personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$5,950.00 be set up as additional revenue in the Emergency Management Hazardous Materials Planning Division Training Revenue Account 81812 and be credited to the General Fund and that \$5,950.00 be transferred from the General Fund to the Hazardous Materials Planning Division Training Expense Account 31133.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all unexpected funds and unrecognized revenues from this account be carried forward from the 2015 to the 2016 budget period.
