15 16	incident, thus determining personal protection equipment requirements, equipment needed to mitigate the situation, and decon needs. This technician level training is not available within the
17	Madison Fire Department.

19	Total cost for this training is \$5,950 which includes instructors and material fees. This course will
20	be repeated three times (over the course of three days) to incorporate "shifts" of fire personnel.
