Smoke-Free Public Housing: CDA & DCHA

Community Development Authority (CDA): CDA board voted on Dec. 8, 2016 to implement a smoke-free policy for all public housing properties. The policy will prohibit the use of lit tobacco products (cigarettes, cigars, hookahs, pipes) and e-cigarettes on all CDA-owned grounds. The policy is effective January 1, 2018. It will impact 742 units, housing 1302 residents.

Public health staff plans to work closely with CDA staff and UW-Health medical residents to coordinate smoking cessation support groups/classes onsite for CDA residents who want to quit smoking. PHMDC staff will also provide CDA with free metal smoke-free property signage and TA throughout the implementation phase, as well as after the policy is implemented.

Dane County Housing Authority (DCHA): DCHA will implement their smoke-free policy on HUD's timeline (tentatively effective August 2018) and will prohibit lit tobacco products and e-cigarettes for not only their public housing units, but USDA Rural Development and Market Rate properties, impacting 102 units throughout the county.



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
