Motion: (revenue/expenditure/text effect) Program/Personnel Effect:	To increase expenditures by \$60,000 to fund the Better Urban Infill Land Development (BUILD) program. The BUILD program was launched in 1999 to foster the following objectives: make better use of existing infrastructure; locate community services, jobs, and shopping in close proximity; stabilize and enhance existing neighborhoods, downtowns, and other business districts; produce housing and jobs for low to moderate-income people; avoid converting productive farmland on urban fringes and rural areas; provide viable options to auto trips by supporting walking, biking, and transit; and have the potential to clean up environmentally contaminated sites. The program was suspended in 2009 with the economic downturn. The program issued over 70 grants to municipalities for development plans for infill, downtown redevelopment etc. Program was re-established in 2015 w/funds appropriated iin the 2013 budget. 7 projects have been awarded grants with those funds.
