

DECLARATION OF SOLID WASTE EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS PROPERTY

The Department of Public Works, Highway & Transportation Solid Waste Division has equipment that is unsuitable and/or unnecessary, and the Division does not intend to trade these pieces of equipment in for other equipment. The pieces of equipment and their original purchase prices are:

2008 McCloskey Trommel Screen - \$278,950.00

2010 Komptech Topturn X67 Windrow Turner - \$544,900.00

2012 Marathon BLOKPAC 3000 Stationary Waste Compactor - \$737,738.00

Public Works staff and the Purchasing Manager recommend the sale of this equipment as surplus.

Pursuant to Dane County Ordinance 25.12(4), no property with an original cost to the County of more than \$200,000 shall be considered surplus until declared as such by the County Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the above listed pieces of equipment are declared surplus;

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Purchasing Manager be authorized to sell the above listed equipment as surplus, pursuant to Dane County Ordinance 25.12.
