Legislative History

4/6/21 Redistricting Commission direction for staff

The Commission discussed strategies for increasing public participation in the district mapping process. Members of the public provided comments in the online chat (see "chat.txt" document attached to minutes). Major topics included:

- Difficulty engaging public on complex issues, based on experience with state Fair Maps commission;
- Making sure people understand why districting issues matter to them and how they will benefit from fair maps;
- Ability to have instructional videos to step people through the mapping process
- ID'ing target populations, including communities of color, municipal clerks, urban / rural populations, and others
- Tapping into other groups to help spread the word and encourage participation
- Need for a 1-page introduction and summary of the project
- Ability of Commissioners to use own contacts to publicize and encourage participation

The Commission reviewed a proposal from Representable.org to help define communities of interest.

Motion by Wilson, second by Oyama-Miller to develop a contract with Representable.org to develop a customized platform for Dane County, provide Spanish and Hmong translations and develop customer support and public outreach materials, consistent with Representable.org's March 24, 2021 proposal.
