Yahara WINs Pilot Cost Share Project - Vertical Manure Injection Systems

Connors presented the proposal from the Yahara Pride Farmers Group to cost share the purchase of equipment for vertical manure injection. The goal of the proposal is to reduce manure and phosphorous runoff by injecting manure in the soil at the time of application.
