

DANE COUNTY GRANT AWARD TO THE TOWN OF WESTPORT
FOR PHASE I OF THE NORTH MENDOTA TRAIL

Dane County Land & Water Resources Department desires to award a capital grant to the Town of Westport for development of the first phase of a multi-use trail in the Town of Westport that extends between Woodland Drive and North Shore Bay Drive. The Town has worked with a private consultant and completed plans necessary to construct the trail. The trail will be a combination of boardwalk, an at-grade paved path and a clear span bridge over Six Mile Creek and is within the current Dane County Highway CTH M planning area project boundary.

The estimated project costs for the project total \$1,200,000. The Dane County Park Commission recommends up to \$1,200,000 in County grant funds from the Land & Water Resources Lewis Lunney Fund.

The term of the debt issued to support this expenditure will be 10 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that a grant of \$1,200,000 to The Town of Westport is approved by the Dane County Board and the Dane County Executive and that the County will pay up to the grant amount based on actual project expenses.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the County Executive and the County Clerk are authorized to execute documents necessary to effectuate the grant award, which may include grant agreements and management agreements.
