CREATING CHAPTER 50 OF THE DANE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, PROHIBITING DISCHARGE OF POLLUTANTS TO THE WATERS OF DANE COUNTY

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -
 The purpose of creating this Chapter is to provide for the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of Dane County and protect surface waters and groundwaters of Dane County by preventing potentially polluting substances from reaching the municipal storm sewer system, lakes, streams, wetlands and groundwater as required by federal and state law.

Current Policy or Practice -
 Creating new chapters of the Dane County Code of Ordinances requires County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -
 This Chapter establishes methods for controlling the discharge of potentially polluting substances into the municipal storm sewer system in order to comply with the requirements of the Clean Water Act, Chapter 283.33, Wis. Stats., and Wisconsin Pollutant Discharge Elimination System municipal stormwater discharge permit program under Chapter NR 216, Wis. Adm. Code.
