AMENDING CHAPTER 53 OF THE DANE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, REGARDING FISHING ON BODIES OF WATER DESIGNATED UNDER THE URBAN FISHING PROGRAM

## **Policy Analysis Statement:**

Brief Description of Proposal -

ARTICLE 2. Section 53.03(22) is created to read as follows:

(22) Fishing or attempting to fish in violation of posted restrictions on bodies of water designated by the Department of Natural Resources under the Urban Fishing Program pursuant to WIS. STAT. s. 29.053(2)(a) and WIS. ADMIN. CODE s. DNR 20.33.

Current Policy or Practice -

Ordinance Amendments require County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

DNR has authority to limit fishing on small bodies of water in urban areas to juveniles 15-years of age and younger and certain disabled anglers may fish these waters. This amendment would prohibit fishing in violation of such posted restrictions on bodies of water in Dane County Parks, and gives Parks Department staff authority to enforce such restrictions. The WI DNR has approved Jenni and Kyle Preserve as an urban fishing area.
