c. Dorn Creek Wildlife Area - Invasive Species Removal and Biofuel Project

Kwitek indicated that there may be some press related to an innovative restoration project that will be occurring at Dorn Creek Wildlife Area starting in the next few weeks. Staff worked with USFWS to contract with a timber company for the removal of invasive species such as box elder and black locust, which will be chipped and utilized for biofuels.
