DEFERRED PROSECUTION OPIATE DIVERSION PROGRAM**

A previously negotiated Interagency Agreement Amendment with the Dane County District Attorney's Office and the University of Wisconsin Population Health Institute to provide technical Assistance with the Opiate Diversion Program for Treatment Alternatives and Diversion Project expired on December 31, 2025.

An extension of the Interagency Agreement Amendment to provide technical Assistance with the Opiate Diversion Program #MSN260999 for Treatment Alternative and Diversion Project Year 5 (2026) Agreement has been negotiated as Follows:

Revision: increase the contract total from the current amount of \$120,000 to a total of \$150,000, a change of \$30,000.

Revision: Change the end date from December 31, 2025, to December 31, 2026.

All other terms and conditions of the original agreement remain unchanged.

This contract addendum exceeds \$100,000 and requires a resolution and confirmation by the Dane County Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Executive and the Dane County Board of Supervisors authorize the year four extension to this agreement.

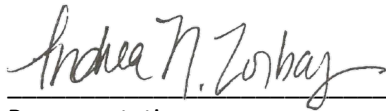
