2. Program Updates

Genter reported that a) Work groups established by the Public Protection & Judiciary Committee are formulating recommendations on the Dane County Jail, racial disparities, services to inmates, and alternatives to incarceration. Their recommendations are due to the County Board Office in early September; b) This year's projected deficit for adult inpatient care at WMHI and MMHI is about \$1 million, and DCDHS staff are working on how to improve insurance collections; c) DCDHS's 2016 Budget Request will be submitted to the Dept. of Administration on August 28th, with the County Board's public hearing on the Request scheduled for Wednesday, September 16 at Alliant Energy Center; d) Lynn Green met recently with WDHS leadership. WDHS staff are drafting an application to the federal government on Family Care 2, and no date has been set for implementation of Family Care in Dane County.
