The Falk Wells Sugar River Wildlife Area is a recreation destination along the Sugar
River. The property is located in southwestern Dane County and offers opportunities for
both land and water activities.

9 The property is located along both sides of the Sugar River and two bridge locations 10 have been identified that would improve access to the overall property. One of the 11 locations is near the south end of the property, which is physically separated from the 12 north end. Acquiring an area of approximately 4 acres, currently in private ownership, is 13 necessary to bridge the gap between the north and south ends of the Falk Wells Sugar 14 River Wildlife Area.

The purchase price for the approximate 4 acres has been established at \$42,000.
Funds for the purchase are available in the Conservation Fund. The debt issued to

- 18 support this expenditure will have a term of 20 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and
 the Dane County Executive hereby authorize the purchase of approximately 4 acres

from the Dennis Himsel for \$42,000 according to Wis. Stats Chapter 27.03(3); and

closing and the transfer of the above-mentioned property to Dane County and the
