AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT TO ACCEPT HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT FUNDS FOR AN ANTI-TEXTING/INATTENTIVE DRIVING ENFORCEMENT CAMPAIGN GRANT NUMBER FG-2015-DANE CO-02851

The Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, State of Wisconsin, is making funds available for participation in a 2015 Anti-Texting/Inattentive Driving Enforcement Project, Grant Number FG-2015-DANE CO-02851. Funding is available for enforcement activities October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015.

The goal of the federally funded enforcement project is to decrease the number of person's texting while driving and ultimately reduce traffic crashes. Texting has quickly become a leading cause of crashes related to inattentive driving. The Beltline Highway, the targeted area for this enforcement effort, is undergoing a large construction project which further supports the need for additional enforcement of texting/distractive driving.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to accept \$9,760 from the Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, for the Anti-Texting/Inattentive Driving Enforcement Grant, targeting the beltline highway; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$9,760 is set up as additional revenue in the Sheriff's Office, Field Services revenue account, SHRFFLD 82534, Anti-Texting/Driving Enforcement and is credited to the General Fund; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$9,760 is transferred from the General Fund to the following accounts:

Overtime Texting/Inattentive (SHRFFLD 10035)	\$8,000
Retirement (SHRFFLD 10099)	\$900
Social Security (SHRFFLD 10108)	\$600
Worker's Compensation (SHRFFLD 10189)	\$260
