Public Health Madison and Dane County is authorized to reduce the fees associated with food 19 20 and drink establishments, temporary food establishments, tattoo and body piercing, hotels and 21 tourist rooming houses, campgrounds and recreational campgrounds to the 2019 rate and waive late fees and offer renewal fee deferment if not contrary to Wisconsin Department of 22 23 Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection guidelines. 24
