2 AUTHORIZING PUBLIC HEALTH TO REDUCE FEES FOR SEVERAL LICENSED
3 ESTABLISHMENTS TO THE 2019 RATE, TO WAIVE LATE FEES AND OFFER RENEWAL
4 FEE DEFERMENT WHERE AUTHORIZED
5

6 On March 23, 2020, pursuant to Madison General Ordinance Section 3.19, the Mayor issued
7 an Emergency Proclamation, based on the increasing transmission of COVID-19 within the City
8 of Madison; and
9

10 On March 24, 2020, the Governor of Wisconsin issued Emergency Order #12 ordering
11 individuals to remain home except for Essential Travel; and
12

13 As part of the Governor's Order all Nonessential Businesses are required to close; and
14

15 The closure of numerous businesses throughout the City has the potential to have significant
16 financial impact on residents.

18 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that effective April 1, 2020 until December 31, 2020,
19 Public Health Madison and Dane County is authorized to reduce the fees associated with food
20 and drink establishments, temporary food establishments, tattoo and body piercing, hotels and
21 tourist rooming houses, campgrounds and recreational campgrounds to the 2019 rate and
22 waive late fees and offer renewal fee deferment if not contrary to Wisconsin Department of
23 Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection guidelines.
