APPROVING THE CONTRACT ADDENDUM FOR THE THIRD PHASE OF THE WEBSITE REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Dane County released RFP# 117053 in 2017 to redesign Dane County websites. From
that Request for Proposals, Dane County selected Ascedia Inc. to lead the website
redesign project and awarded Dane County Contract # 13339 to Ascedia.

In creating the initial agreement with Ascedia, the project was divided into multiple
 phases. The first phase of the project is complete. Work on the second phase is on going and scheduled to be completed by October 2020.

This addendum adds to the initial agreement the scope, timeline, and cost of the third phase of the project. The third phase includes redeveloping the websites of the County

Board, the County Clerk, the Clerk of Courts, the Register of Deeds, the County Sheriff,
 the District Attorney, the County Treasurer, the Juvenile Court Program, and several

19 interdepartmental websites.

The 2020 Capital Budget allocated \$150,000 for the third phase of the website redesign project. An Addendum has been negotiated to complete the third phase of the project for \$65,900.

25 Therefore, be it resolved that the County Executive and County Clerk are

authorized to execute the addendum agreement with Ascedia Inc. for \$65,900.



THIS ADDENDUM, made and entered into effective as of the date by which both parties hereto have executed this document, by and between the County of Dane (hereinafter referred to as "County") and Ascedia Inc. (hereinafter, "Provider").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS Provider and County, by a separate document (hereinafter, the "Master Agreement"), Dane County Contract #13339, have previously entered into a contractual relationship pursuant to which Provider shall redesign the County's websites, and

WHEREAS County and Provider wish to amend the Master Agreement in order to expand the scope of the initial agreement to include additional websites that were not included in the original Master Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises and the mutual covenants of the parties hereinafter set forth, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by each party for itself, the parties do agree as follows:

- 1. The Master Agreement shall remain in full force and effect unchanged in any manner by this addendum except as changes are expressly set forth herein. This addendum shall control only to the extent of any conflict between the terms of the Master Agreement and this addendum.
- 2. The attached schedules J, K, and L describe the expanded scope, the timeline of the expanded scope, and payment for the third phase of the project.

Schedule J: Phase 3 – Expanded Scope

PROVIDER and COUNTY will:

Weekly reports & conference calls – PROVIDER and COUNTY will have weekly status calls at a mutually agreed upon time. A weekly written status report will consist of a running update of what progress is made, key deliverables and dates, concerns, etc. and will be emailed to Dane County each week.

Weekly development meeting – PROVIDER and COUNTY will have a weekly development status call at a mutually agreed upon time.

Face-to-face meetings – Face-to-face meetings will be scheduled at times when key deliverables and reviews occur. The dates of these meetings will be decided upon by COUNTY and PROVIDER.

Iterative reviews – Iterative reviews will be slightly more ad hoc than other meetings, as these will occur every two weeks to allow both sides to communicate through smaller changes in the application. Not all parties will be able to participate in all iterative reviews, but if a representative from a particular department is needed, this request will be made the prior day by PROVIDER, when time allows.

Documentation & team communication, bug reporting – Basecamp & Jira will be set up by PROVIDER and used by COUNTY and PROVIDER for all team communication, documentation storage and access, and bug reporting during the testing phases. COUNTY will invite PROVIDER to appropriate Trello boards for the project.

Websites Delivered:

All sites below shall be delivered by PROVIDER and become property of COUNTY upon delivery. Sites will support multiple languages and will comply with WCAG 2.0 – AA standards for website accessibility.
