

Create an agriculture lot for hunting	Location: North of 3524 Old



DESCRIPTION: Applicant proposes to create a separate ~24 acre parcel to be sold as hunting/recreational land. The proposed A-4 Agriculture Zoning District prohibits residences from being constructed on the property.

OBSERVATIONS: The majority of the proposed parcel is covered by wetlands and hydric soils. FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) designate the property assigned as a flood hazard area. No development is proposed.

TOWN PLAN: The property is located in the town's agricultural preservation area.

RESOURCE PROTECTION: A resource protection corridor is located on the property associated with a large wetland complex.

STAFF: The property is not eligible for any additional non-farm residential development under the town plan. Creation of the 24 acre open space parcel appears reasonably consistent with town plan policies. A waiver from the 66' of road frontage requirement will be required. Staff suggests recording of an access easement to provide ingress/egress to the property.

NOTE: Any grading or land disturbing activity in the wetland area requires approval from Army Corps of Engineers, Wisconsin DNR, and Dane County.

3/22 ZLR: The petition was postponed due to no town action.

TOWN: Approved with no conditions.
