McCallum discussed BEAD timeline with Task Force with the BEAD round 1 grant application opening on January 13th. Additionally the PSC recommended that the local endorsement process wrapped up on January 30th. Also the resolution to endorse projects or providers in Dane County would likely be introduced to the County Board on December 19th with it returning to the County Board in January pending approval in other committees.

Federal government approved the list of eligible locations for the BEAD program provided by the PSC.

PSC is hosting a webinar with information on the BEAD program on December 17th from 1pm-2pm.
