Review 2021-2023 WCA Legislative Agenda

The ZLR Committee reviewed the 2021-23 Dane County Legislative Agenda. Supervisor Kiefer pointed out that the agenda item incorrectly identified the legislative agenda as the Wisconsin Counties Association Legislative Agenda. Carrie Springer, Dane County Lobbyist, provided an overview of the list of agenda items. Supervisor Kiefer would like to see that Line item 657 (North Mendota Parkway: Oppose the construction of four lanes on Main 657 Street (HWY 19) in Waunakee) be part of the list of priorities. He also stated that the language in Line item 113 (Climate Change) and Line item 642 (Wisconsin 2030 State Rail Plan) should be updated to reflect current information.

The ZLR Committee would like to see that the Dane County Legislative Agenda prioritize the following three issues: Climate Change (with special emphasis on flooding), Broadband Expansion in rural areas, and Local Control of land use decisions.
