Lease Agreement with WISDOT Regarding Use of State Lands for Garage and Salt Storage Facilities

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

The Dane County Dept of Public Works, Highway & Transportation and representatives of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation have determined that a lease is required to provide for continuation of use of state lands by the County of Dane for purposes of vehicular storage and salt storage facilities.

Current Policy or Practice -

No rent shall be charged by the Department or paid by the County for this lease. The term of the lease is 40 (forty) years.

The County shall maintain all improvements including green space and paved areas, and shall provide insurance on the property.
