2024 Spring Friends Grant Application Summary

The Foundation for Dane County Parks and Dane County Parks collaborative grant program is open to Dane County Parks Friend Groups and partner organizations to lead educational programs, implement small projects, and purchase equipment for volunteer workdays. This collaborative grant program can fund a full or partial project/program between \$250-\$2,000. Funding comes from the Dane County Parks Operating Budget (\$6,000) and the Madison Community Foundation's Friends of Dane County Parks Endowment Fund distribution. The spring grant application period ran from February 15, 2024 to April 1, 2024. The Foundation for Dane County Parks Board met on Tuesday, May 14th and voted to award grants as outlined below.
