**AUTHORIZING A RAPID RESPONSE AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES (AIS) GRANT FOR
INDIAN LAKE FROM THE WI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES**

The Land & Water Resources Department (LWRD) has obtained a cost share grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) for the purposes of removing common carp and monitoring in-lake improvements at Indian Lake. Indian Lake is located within Indian Lake County Park in the Town of Berry.

The purpose of the grant is to provide Dane County LWRD the ability to further reduce the common carp population in Indian Lake through commercial fishing. The water quality improvements will be documented through a monitoring plan including the use of sonar and standard chemical analysis. The required match for this project would be met by in-kind county expenditures for fuel, mileage and additional staff hours.

WHEREAS, Dane County LWRD attests to the validity and veracity of statements and representations contained in the grant application;

WHEREAS, Dane County LWRD has budgeted a sum sufficient to fully and satisfactorily complete the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Water Resource Planner or the County Executive are authorized to execute all documents necessary to apply for and accept the funds, submit reports and reimbursement requests and all other applicable documents to fulfill grant requirements.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that a new LWRPKOP revenue and expense account "Indian Lake Aquatic AIS Grant" shall be established for \$17,100. All Funds shall be carried forward until realized and expended.
