Disorderly conduct bookings in the Jail

Tamarine Cornelius, CJC Research Analyst discusses the Disorderly Conduct Booking Analysis. Discussion ensues around person level versus case level detail; different age populations and varying locations. Discussion around what the Dane County will do with community members to negate the need for law enforcement intervention.
