AGREEMENT FOR THE FINAL DESIGN OF COUNTY TRUNK HIGHWAY M (CTH M) FROM PRAIRIE HILL ROAD TO CROSS COUNTRY ROAD

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between the County of Dane, a quasimunicipal corporation in the State of Wisconsin (hereinafter referred to as "County"); the City of Verona, and the City of Madison, municipal corporations of the State of Wisconsin (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Cities" and individually as "Verona" and "Madison."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS the Cities, the County, and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, have determined that County Trunk Highway ("CTH") M, from Prairie Hill Road to Cross Country Road, located in the Cities, is in need of reconstruction ("the Project"), and the final design will require contributions from the Cities and County;

WHEREAS Madison has entered into an agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to design and construct the Project.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 66.0301 Wis. Stats. the Cities and the County wish to formalize arrangements for the local share of the Project's final design engineering costs;

WHEREAS funding is to be accomplished in accordance with past policies of cost sharing on similar CTH projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises and the mutual covenants of the parties hereinafter set forth, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by each party for itself, the Cities and the County do agree as follows:

- 1. The Project shall consist of reconstructing CTH "M", from Prairie Hill Road to Cross Country Road into an improved divided roadway, with sidewalk, bike lanes, and turn lanes
- 2. The Project is intended to be designed in 2011-2015 with construction in 2016.
- 3. This Agreement covers the final design engineering and production of final plans, specifications and estimates of the Project.
- 4. The County and the Cities agree to joint financial participation in the design engineering costs for the Project, as set forth in this Agreement and as delineated in the County's "Policy for Joint Projects with Municipalities" adopted May 3, 1999.
- 5. The Cities and the County shall share in the design engineering of the project as follows:

- 6. Prior to or concurrent with the approval of plans, specifications, estimates of cost, and authorization of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to issue the bid documents, the County and the Cities may execute an addendum to this Agreement which will note additional cost sharing items and the financial commitments of the parties for the Project. Any amendments to this Agreement shall be in writing.
- 7. At the request of the parties, Madison shall manage the PROJECT. Madison shall bill the County and Verona for their respective share of the design engineering costs as specified herein.
- 8. The County and Verona will reimburse Madison, within 60 days of billing, for completed services according to the responsibilities stated above.
- 9. The County and the Cities shall cooperate and jointly participate in the public meetings and meetings with stakeholders through the consultant selection and environmental review phase of the Project. The consultant shall be jointly selected by the County and the Cities.
- 10. In the performance of the obligations under this Agreement, the Parties agree to abide by their own respective affirmative action plans and in doing so agree not to discriminate, in violation of any state or federal law, against any employee or applicant because of race, religion, marital status, age, color, sex, handicap, national origin or ancestry, income level or source of income, arrest record or conviction record, less than honorable discharge, physical appearance, sexual orientation, gender identity, political beliefs, or student status. The parties further agree not to discriminate, in violation of any state or federal law, against any subcontractor or person who offers to subcontract on this Agreement because of race, religion, color, age, disability, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or national origin.
- 11. Each party shall be responsible for the consequences of its own acts, errors, or omissions and those of its employees, boards, commissions, agencies, officers, and representatives and shall be responsible for any losses, claims, and liabilities which are attributable to such acts, errors, or omissions including providing its own defense. In situations including joint liability, each party shall be responsible for the consequences of its own acts, errors, or omissions and those of its employees, agents, boards, commissions, agencies, officers and representatives. It is not the intent of the parties to impose liability beyond that imposed by state statutes.
- 12. Each party warrants for itself that it has complied with all applicable statutes, rules, orders, ordinances, requirements and regulations to execute this Agreement, and that the person or persons executing this Agreement on its behalf is authorized to do so.
- 13. The parties may evidence their agreement to the foregoing upon one or several counterparts of this instrument, which together shall constitute a single instrument.
