Safe Food Advisory Committee

Resolution 2008-18

Prior to the merger, Madison Department of Public Health had a Safe Food Advisory Committee that created a forum for communication between the Department and the food industry. Public Health—Madison and Dane County would like to reform this committee.

The purpose of the Safe Food Advisory Committee is to advise staff on improvements needed in the food inspection program, evaluate industry training and identify training needs, and discuss new safety concerns and how they can be addressed by the industry.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Safe Food Advisory Committee be created with members appointed by the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee be comprised of approximately ten food operators identified by Public Health—Madison and Dane County who have indicated a willingness to work with the Department in improving Public Health within the food industry with assistance from Department staff; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Committee will meet as a whole or in issue-oriented groups at least quarterly, with a report to the Board on its activities each year.
