AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF MICROSOFT
LICENSING AND MICROSOFT SERVER LICENSING

The 2018 Budget includes funding to enter into a new Enterprise Agreement with Microsoft to upgrade and extend the County's Microsoft software licenses. This resolution authorizes licensing for servers and will complete the County's licensing obligations with Microsoft for a three year period.

The licensing agreement provides Datacenter and SQL server licensing for a three year period at a cost of \$632,717.88 (\$210,905.96 Annually). These licenses are necessary to support the physical and virtual servers that host and support end user applications.

This licensing agreement includes Software Assurance (SA) which provides updates and support for Windows Office products and Citrix access capabilities at a cost of \$1,018,593.33 (\$339,531.11 Annually). The agreement also grants access to training vouchers for technical staff, online learning, implementation planning services, technical support services, and the home use program.

The total project cost of \$1,651,311.21 will cover any upgrades that are needed during a three-year period. At the end of this three-year commitment, the County may decide to purchase another three-year licensing package or to discontinue the agreement.

The term of the debt issued to fund this project will be three years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that County Executive and County Clerk are authorized to enter into an agreement with SHI International Corp to purchase Server and Cloud Enrollment (SCE) licensing and Microsoft licensing.
