AMENDING CHAPTER 76 OF THE DANE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES,
REGARDING ISSUANCE OF BUILDING NUMBERS FOR PARCELS
WITHOUT A BUILDING

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Dane does ordain as follows:

ARTICLE 1. Unless otherwise expressly stated herein, all references to section and chapter numbers are to those of the Dane County Code of Ordinances.

ARTICLE 2. Section 76.05 is amended to read as follows:

76.05 BUILDING NUMBERING ADMINISTRATION. (1) Oversight for the rural numbering system shall be provided by the committee and shall be administered by the department.

(2) *Costs.* The costs of administering the rural numbering system shall be included in the budget of the department.

(3) *Official numbering maps.* The official numbering map shall be maintained by the department on a scale of not less than 1 inch = 1,000 feet, showing the location of all numbers assigned. Copies of official numbering maps for each town shall be furnished to all rural fire departments responsible for fire protection in that town, the Dane County Sheriff's Department, the clerk of the town, the Dane County Public Safety Communications Department, the Dane County Emergency Management Department and any other department or organization providing emergency services in the town. Thereafter, on a biennial basis, all numbers assigned for new buildings shall be placed on the map and copies thereof be provided as above. Maps of subdivisions shall be provided on map sheets measuring 18 inches square and the location of the subdivision shall be shown on the official numbering map.

(4) *New buildings.* When a zoning permit is issued for any new residential, or any new commercial, business or industrial location, a number shall be assigned to that location.

(5) *Parcels without buildings.* The zoning administrator shall issue a number to parcels without a building upon application by the owner.

~~(56)~~ *Rules.* The committee may make reasonable rules necessary to provide for the orderly and speedy implementation of the rural numbering system.

ARTICLE 3. Section 76.07(1) is amended to read as follows:

76.07 BUILDING NUMBERING. (1) General. (a) The sign shall be installed so that the numbers are perpendicular to the roadway and the post shall be located not more than ten (10) feet from the right of way of the road and not more than ten (10) feet from the driveway serving the building or parcel. A parallel placement option may be allowed by the Town. The sign shall be installed to be not less than 3½ feet nor more than 4½ feet from ground level and shall not be concealed from view of the road.

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[EXPLANATION: This amendment authorizes the issuance of a rural building number to parcels without a building.]
